The arc is only accessible through an underground tunnel. Just walk around the outside of Etoile (the traffic circle with the Arc in the middle) until you get to the underpass. 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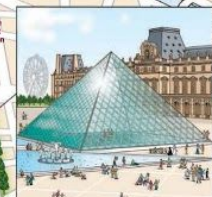
